



FRITZ Jean Paul

(1876 - 1941) ¹

Luxembourg-city

Biography

Jean Paul FRITZ was born in 1876 in Luxembourg-city (Arsenalstrasse). He was the eldest son of François Christophe FRITZ, whose occupation was *Betriebs Secretär.* ²

In the early 1910s Jean Paul FRITZ resided in Dudelange; his occupation was Bürovorsteher.

When, at the age of 53, he married Berthe Marguerite SCHLESSER in 1929, his occupation was recorded in the Civil Register as *comptable principal pensionné*. His place of residence was Luxembourg-city and his wife resided in Dudelange.

Jean Paul FRITZ died in Brussels in 1941. He was remembered as pensionierter Hauptbuchhalter der ARBED.
