



LUDWIG Charles

(1872 - 1924) ¹ Aspelt

Biography

Charles LUDWIG, born in 1872 in Aspelt, was the son of Ferdinand LUDWIG *Grenzaufseher*, born in Martelange.

Charles became himself a *Grenzaufseher* (*Gendarm*). He held positions in Bettembourg, Hosingen (1898 - 1900), Aspelt (1901-1903), Rodange (1903-1906, *Grenzaufseher*) and in 1906 he was promoted to *Polizei-Kommissar* in Differdange.

In 1909 he left public service to become a commerçant in Moyeuvre-Grande (Thionville). ²

His first wife Céline LOSSON, ³ born in the Lorraine, died in 1917 in Metz. Charles LUDWIG worked in Aspelt at the time as *Kaufmann*.

In 1921 he married a second time with Magdalena ARRENSDORFF. His occupation was recorded as *Privatbeamter* and he was resident in Luxembourg-Eich.

LUDWIG died in Luxembourg-Eich in 1924. His occupation was again commerçant.
