

## **WEYMERSKIRCH Théo**

## **Biography**

Théo WEYMERSKIRCH was born in Mühlenbach (Eich). His father's occupation was *Tagelöhner*. The latter died in 1892.

In 1895 Théo's occupation was Tabakarbeiter (?). <sup>2</sup> He resided in his parental home in Weimerskirch.

Théo later obtained an engineering degree and joined the steelworks of Differdange. In 1925 he carried the title of *Betriebschef des Stahlwerkes, Differdingen (chef de service)*.

He resided first in Differdange (rue de l'Acier 3) and in 1928 he moved to Luxembourg-city (place Joseph II).

In the 1950s he resided in boulevard Grande-Duchesse Charlotte 67.

He was a very creative engineer who obtained patents for a total of 25 inventions, made between 1920 and 1934.

WEYMERSKIRCH died in Luxembourg-city in 1977, at the age of 95. He was married twice but had no children.
