## Addendum

### Public attention

#### 1933-1936

In 1933 Paul KROLL bought a vineyard in Grevenmacher, in the part known as “*in der Loch*” for setting up an experimental fruit tree garden. This transaction, including the declared intention of the buyer, was reported in the *Luxemburger Wort* as well as in the *Obermosel-Zeitung*.<sup>1</sup>

Paul’s objective was to test the growth of new types of fruit in the Moselle valley. The interest in this project among the locals was such that the local press reported the successful growth of melons (1935)<sup>2</sup> and (ripe!) almonds (1936),<sup>3</sup> the latter fruits in the “*Schiffmühlenweg*”.

The local reporter wrote:

*Da der Mandelbaum ziemlich reichlich trägt und sozusagen keine Pflege erfordert, ist es nicht ausgeschlossen, daß diese Kultur eine neue Einnahmequelle für unsere Moselgegend erschließen wird.*
